



Dr. Dale Iwanoczko Memorial **Volleyball Scholarship**



Dale Iwanoczko was an outstanding student and athlete, who began his volleyball career playing for Lord Selkirk Regional High School. He advanced to the University of Manitoba where he was named a five time "All Canadian" and "C.I.S Most Valuable Player" in 1991. He was also a member of Manitoba Volleyball Association Provincial Team program. Dale was Valedictorian, "Governor General" Medal Award Winner, and "Athlete of the Year" at Selkirk. He proceeded to obtain his medical degree from the University of Manitoba. Dale Iwanoczko left the sports world at the age of 30 after succumbing to Hodgkin's Disease and a battle he had fought for fourteen months.

Friends and colleagues of Dale have come together to create four seven hundred and fifty dollar (\$750.00) scholarships in his name to be presented to two rural and two urban high school volleyball players.

2008 Scholarship Rules & Regulations

1. Scholarships shall be awarded to student graduating from Grade 12 and enrolling full time in a Canadian University or other recognized Post Secondary Institution.
2. Candidates must complete the application in full and provide all required information, documents, and letters in order for their application to be considered.
3. A candidate must have proficiency in volleyball, a minimum "C" (65%) average in his/her marks.
4. Scholarships will be awarded to those individuals who have shown leadership in the Manitoba amateur sport community through well rounded participation as high school volleyball athletes, as well as on the basis of academic standing, and other community and school activities.

The application must include the following:

- A letter from the Principal certifying the candidate's scholarship, character, and school citizenship.
- A letter from the Coach indicating the candidate's character, volleyball ability, involvement in other school programs, and service in the school.
- A letter from a community member writing on behalf of the candidate referring to his/her leadership qualities, community activities and character.
- Latest transcript of marks.
- A paragraph or two, written by the student, outlining sport involvement and future plans in sport. Please comment on post-secondary and career aspirations as well.

**Only one male and one female application per school will be accepted.
It is the school's responsibility to select their nominees.**
