



Todd Davison Memorial Scholarship

On the ice Todd played the game of hockey with tremendous speed and a big heart, never letting the big guys stop him. A feisty forward in the Western Hockey League and then the Lloydminster Blazers, he wasn't afraid to mix things up in the corners. In June 2004, two days after his graduation day from St. Paul's High School, Todd was introduced to the "biggest opponent he ever faced" Synovial Sarcoma, a rare form of cancer. Todd applied his trademark perseverance and limitless spirit not only to his personal battle with cancer, but also to a larger goal, the fight to end cancer. Inspired by the positive attitude and ongoing work of Lance Armstrong, Lyle Bauer and Mario Lemieux and other athletes who have conquered the disease, Todd strived to make a difference.

Working with friends and family, Todd staged the first Believe in the Goal Hockey game on August 3rd, 2006 and the event raised over \$50,000.00 for the Never Alone Foundation in support of CancerCare. Todd lost his fight with cancer in December 2006, but he continues to inspire all of us to be Difference Makers.

The Never Alone Foundation would like to award the Todd Davidson Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000.00) to a High School athlete who (this award is open to athletes participating in all MHSAA sanctioned sports):

- Has risen above personal challenges in their life
